PRINTMAKING WORKSHOP ARENYS DE MUNT, BARCELONA, SPAIN 5 TO 18 SEPTEMBER 2015

The course is suitable for beginners as well as more experienced artists and printmakers.

The Printmaking Studio

The studio at Art Print Residence is fully equipped and flooded with natural light from 12 linear metres of south facing windows. There are three etching presses and the studio is set up for copper plate etching with the safer mordant of ferric chloride. A vacuum exposure unit provides the opportunity to use photopolymer plate (solarplate). There is an outside area including a garden that can be used when the weather is suitable. The studio has views of the mountains in one direction and views of the ocean in the other.

The Location & Sights

Arenys de Munt is an easy 50 minute train ride (local commuter trains run regularly) or a 30 minute road trip from Barcelona. The region has beautiful beaches, is good for hiking and rich with local culture. The restaurants, cafes and shops of Arenys de Munt and the beach of Arenys de Mar are all walking distance from the studio. September in Spain is much milder in temperatures and perfect for working creatively or exploring the city of Barcelona and the surrounding area of Girona. Barcelona is known for its unique and amazing examples of Gaudi's architecture. There is also the Picasso museum and the Miro museum, as well as the Mies van der Rohe pavilion, or just wander the streets of the charming Gothic Quarter where buildings date back to medieval times. During the workshop there will be plenty of time for printmaking, exploring, swimming or just relaxing.

The Tutor

Susan Baran is your tutor for the duration of the workshop. She is a Sydney based Australian artist/printmaker. Susan trained at East Sydney Technical College, Sydney, NSW (now the National Art School)and the City Art Institute (now College of Fine Arts) majoring in printmaking. She has had over 25 years of teaching experience and has taught printmaking at the National Art School, the Warringah Printmakers Studio and the Pine Street Creative Art Centre in Sydney. Susan has been a tutor for a number of workshops including printmaking courses at Baldessin Press (VICTORIA) Newcastle Printmakers (NSW), Moving Creatures Studio (TASMANIA) Primrose Paper Arts (SYDNEY), Art Vault (MILDURA) & Hazelhurst Gallery (NSW).

Susan Baran has had many solo & group exhibitions in Australia and overseas. Her work is held in the collections of the National Gallery of Australia, the Art Gallery of NSW, Artbank and various regional galleries. She recently completed an artist residency at the Art Vault in Mildura and at the Australian Print Workshop in Melbourne. Focusing on safer printmaking practises, her expertise is with photopolymer plates (solarplate) & etching.

The Course

The techniques to be explored during the Barcelona workshop will be photopolymer plates, copper etching, drypoint and safe etching of lino with caustic soda. During the workshop there will be approximately 60 hours of studio time with excursions for drawing and photography and the option of a

day trip to the beautiful town of Cadaqués to see the Dali Museum & ADOGI - Taller Galeria Fort, home of the Mini Print International de Cadaqués.

The Cost & Inclusions

- A special **Early Bird Price** of \$2300.00 for the total workshop cost will apply if the total payment is made by 1 March, 2015.
- If payment is made after 1 March, 2015 the total workshop cost is \$2500.00.
- A deposit of \$700.00 is required upon booking to secure your place in the workshop.
- The balance of payment must be paid by 1 July, 2015 or, see payment conditions for the **Early Bird Price**
- The course fee covers tuition, studio hire, most materials, morning tea and a welcome dinner.

Travel and accommodation
